

DAY 1 June 4th, 2024

After checking into a hotel and resting a bit, we invite you for a walk around the beautifully rebuilt Old Town of Warsaw which is now a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We walk along the elegant street of Krakowskie Przedmieście admiring the Presidential Palace, see the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the Saski park. In the evening we invite you for a traditional Polish welcome dinner.

DAY 2 June 5th, 2024

We continue exploring Warsaw and start with the Royal
 Castle which was first built there in the 14th century.

 For lunch we visit the traditional pierogi place and afterwards the Chopin Musuem.
 Later we visit the largest park in Warsaw. Developed by Poland's last king, Stanisław August, it's home not only to striking landscapes but also a number of architectural treasures.

DAY 3 June 6th, 2024

Today we start with the Warsaw Rising Museum – a tribute to those who fought and died for the freedom of Poland in 1944. At the exhibition we can feel the struggle of everyday life and the horror of occupation. For lunch we invite you to a traditional Polish Folk-Inn, located in a former Jewish Ghetto. Nowadays it is a very vibrant businesss district. After lunch we take a walk and explore that area a bit more and then you have some free time.

DAY 4 June 7th, 2024

In the morning we leave Warsaw and head to the north-east of Poland. We visit an extermination and labor camp Treblinka built and operated by Nazi Germany in occupied Poland during World War II.
 Later we drive to Białystok, but on the way, we stop for a while in Tykocin. The town was favored by Polish kings, often staying in this area on their way to hunt in the

Białowieża Forest or to Lithuania which for centuries formed

DAY 5 June 8th, 2024

a common state with Poland.

• We start the day with the sightseeing of Białystok. We visit the Old Town and splendid Branicki Palace, which is also known as the 'Polish Versailles'. It is one of the best-preserved magnate residences in Poland. After the lunch we drive to Augustów the city in the heart of a beautiful Masurian Lakes region where we join the canal cruise and admire the beauty of the nature of Rospuda Valley. We stay for the night in Suwałki located near the border with Lithuania.

DAY 6 June 9th, 2024

In the morining we leave **Poland** and head to **Lithuania**. Our first stop on the way is **Kaunas** - Lithuania's second most populous city and the country's largest industrial center. We visit there: the beautiful **Basilica of the Resurrection of Christ, the Old Town** and **the City Hall.** We stop by **the**

 House of Perkūnas - one of the most original Gothic buildings in Lithuania. For the night we drive to Vilnius, where we take a quick walk around the center.

DAY 7 June 10th, 2024

Today we spend the whole day sightseeing Vilnius. We start with the The Gediminas' Tower - one of the best places to see the magnificent panoramas of the city. Our next stop is the Vilnius Cathedral Basilica of St. Stanislaus and St.
 Ladislaus from the 17th century and the Gates of Dawn which used to be a part of Vilnius' defensive wall. After lunch we head to the Museum of Occupations and Freedom Fights situated in the former KGB building.

DAY 8 June 11th, 2024

Today we go for a tour around the **Trakai Castle** in **Vilnius** which was a home to all the Grand Dukes of Lithuania. That ghotic building is located on an island on **Lake Galve**, one of

the deepest lakes in Lithuania. In the summer in this
fairytale-like surrounding there are hosted medieval
festivals as well as various events and concerts in the
castle's courtyard. The rest of the day is a free time to enjoy
the city.



Overnight: Vilnius, 3* or 4* hotel in a central location

DAY 9 June 12th, 2024

In the morning we leave for Riga - one of the largest
 metropolises in the Baltic States and the capital of Latvia.
 You can feel the 800 years of difficult history during a city tour. On the way there we have a lunch in Panevezys. In the local regional restaurant we can taste traditional Latvian dishes. After the hotel check in we go for a walk around the town center and enjoy the atmosphere of the city.

DAY 10 June 13th, 2024

After breakfast we continue the sightseeing of Riga. We visit

 the magnificent Old Town - the historical center of Riga, that has been included on UNESCO's World Heritage List.
 First we climb the viewing tower of St. Peter's Church which offers incredible views of Riga's red-tiled rooftops of the old town and the Daugava River. Then we take a walk to admire the beautiful Riga Cathedral, Town Hall Square and unique historic tenements.

DAY 11 June 14th, 2024

Today is the last day in Riga and it's time to wind down and

 have some free time, before the departure. You can spend the rest of the day enjoying the atmosphere of the city or buying some souvenirs.
